

.....





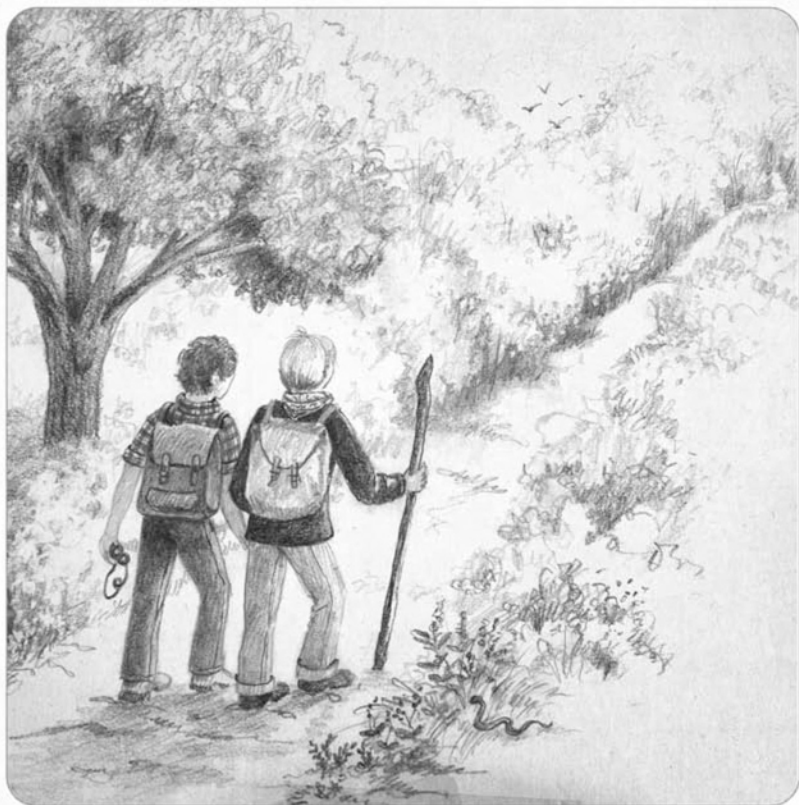

.....





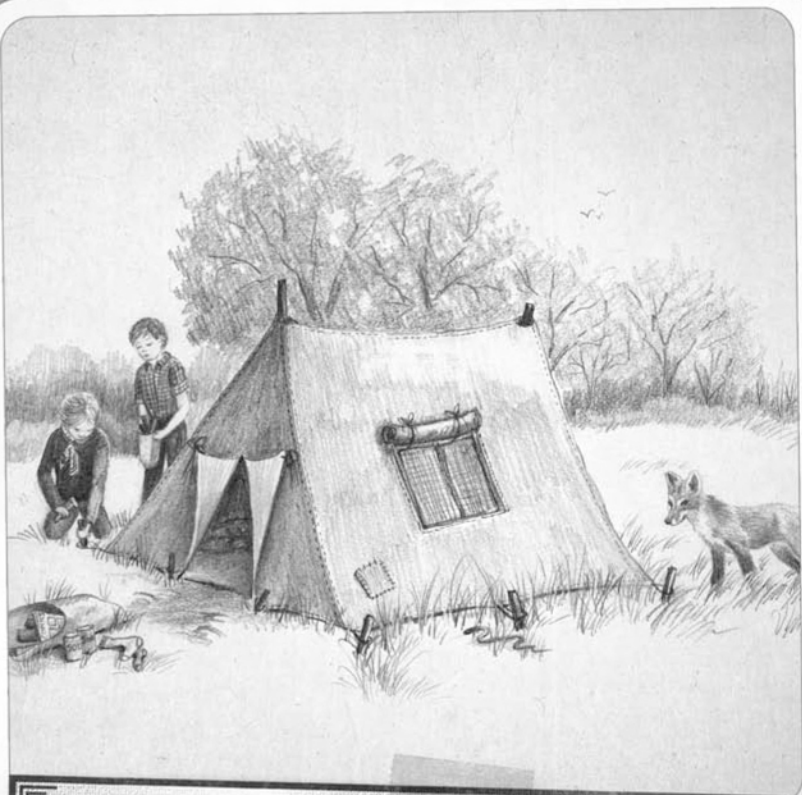
A red fox on the path!

.....



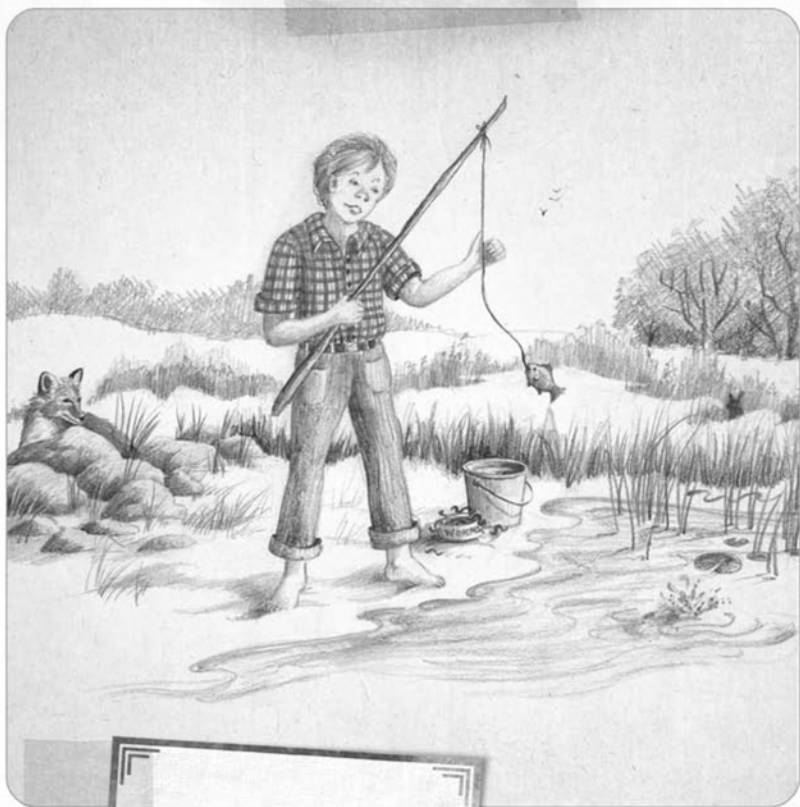
The sun was hot.

Did the fox smell it?



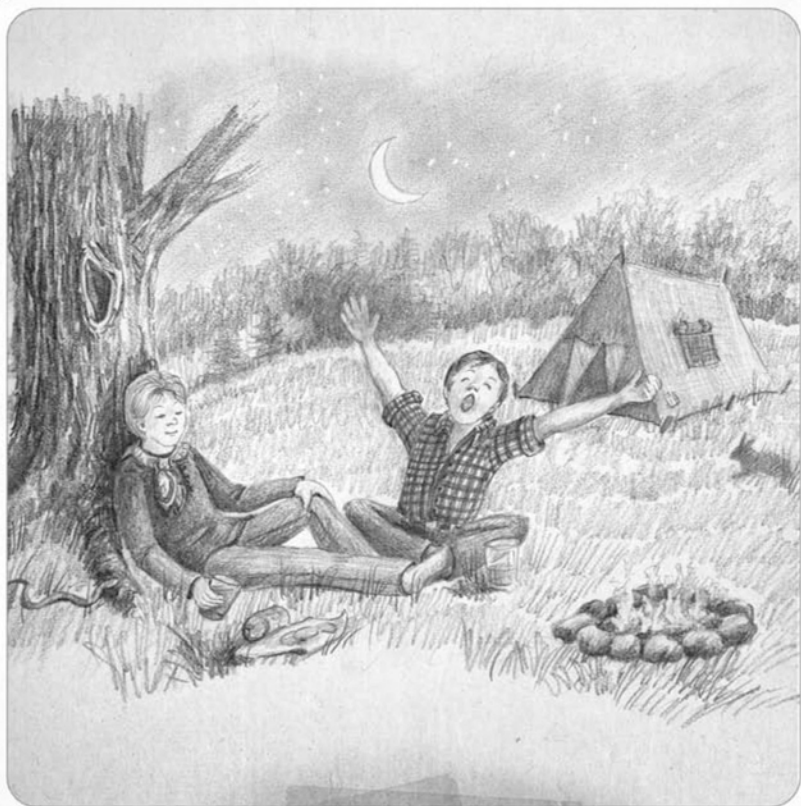
The fox ran with the fish.  
Get him!



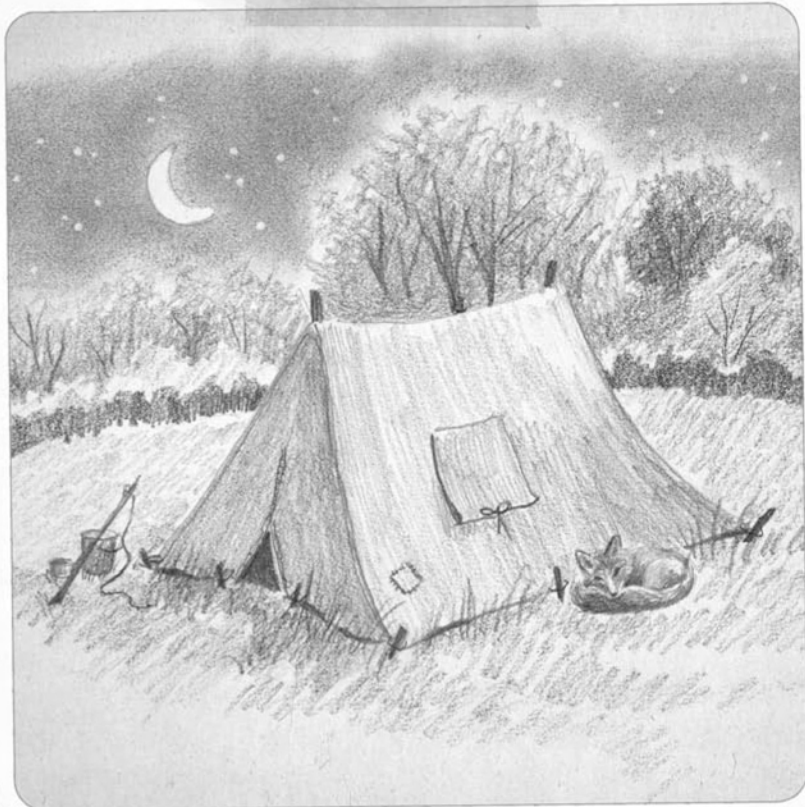
The fish is lost,

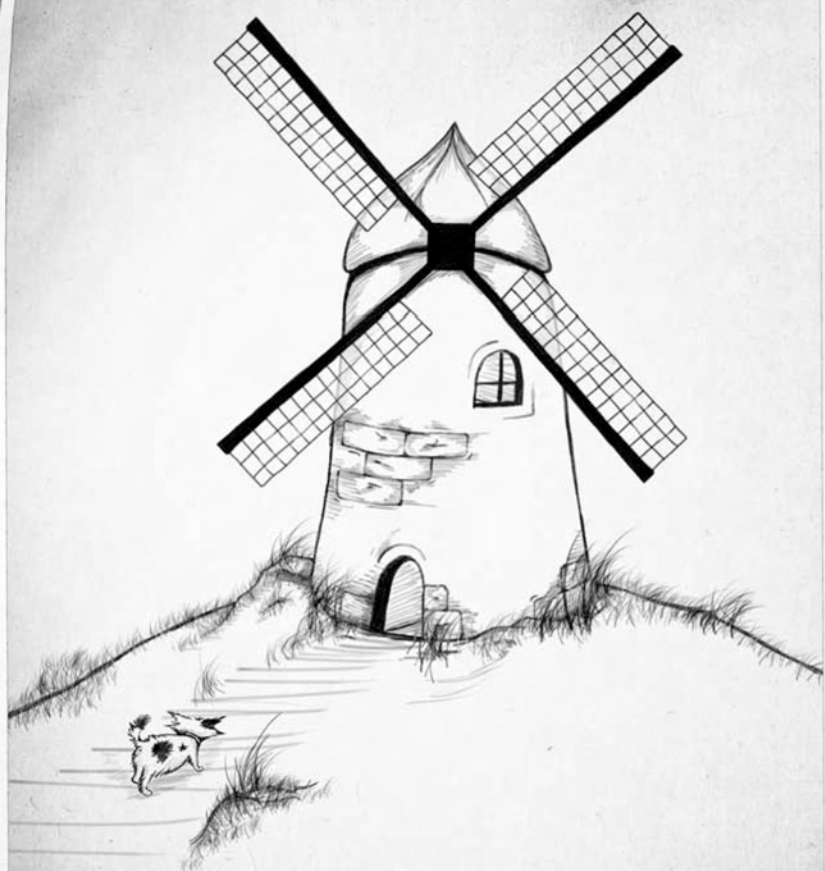
# Cobweb the Cat

upon the hilltop.



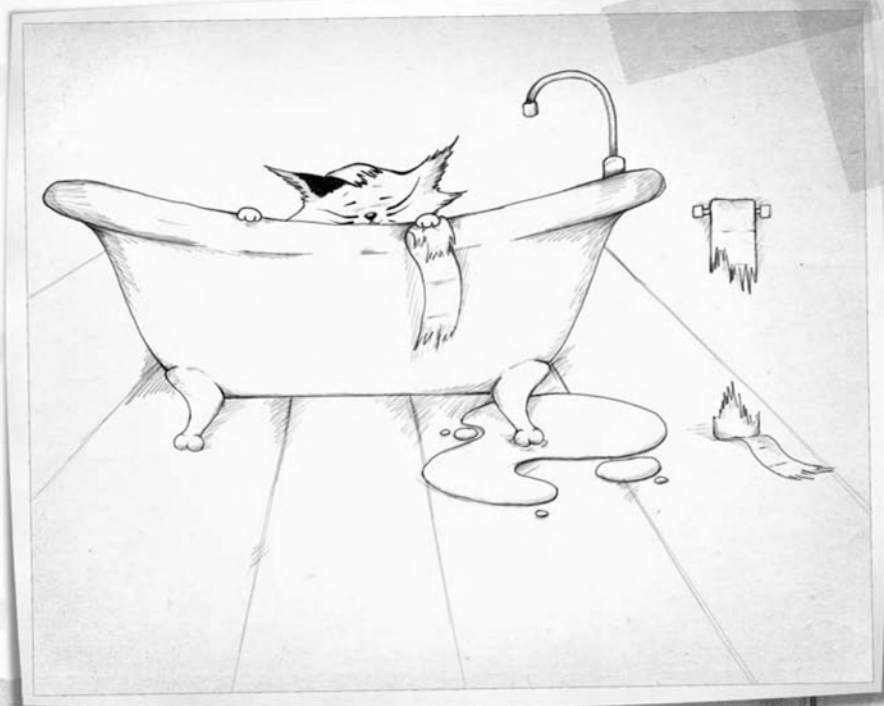


Cobweb had much

with his best pal the bobcat.

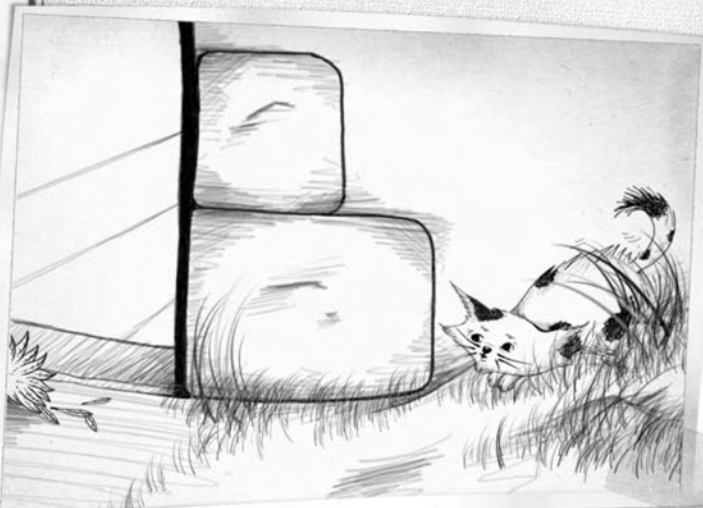
Then he had to help

Next, Cobweb must hunt.

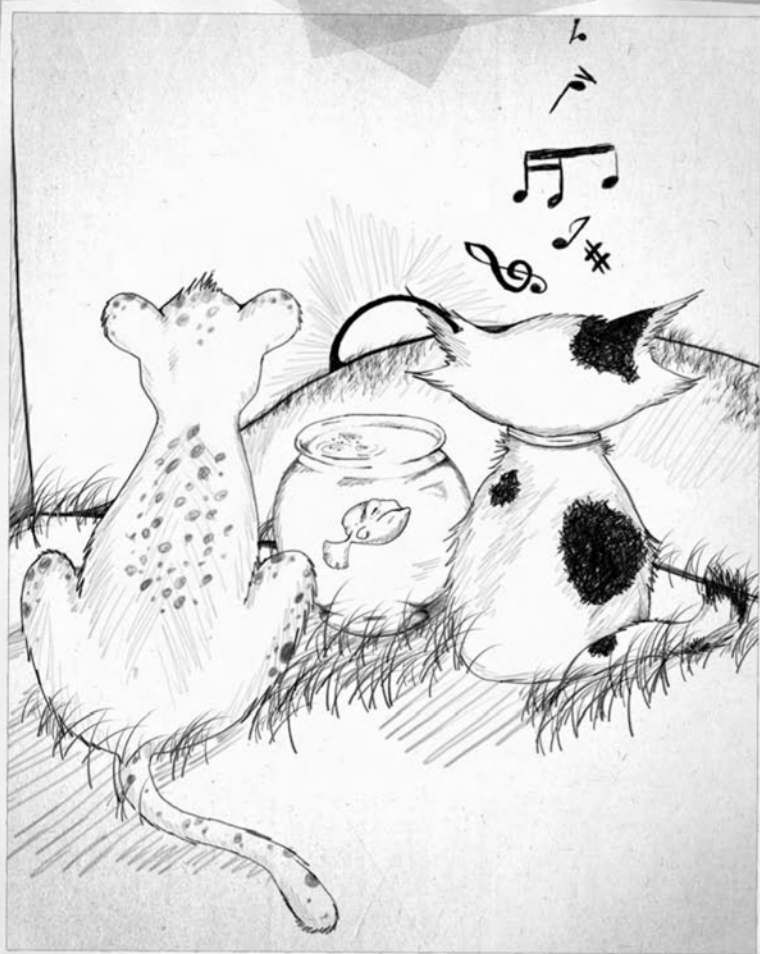
Is that a wing?

Got it!



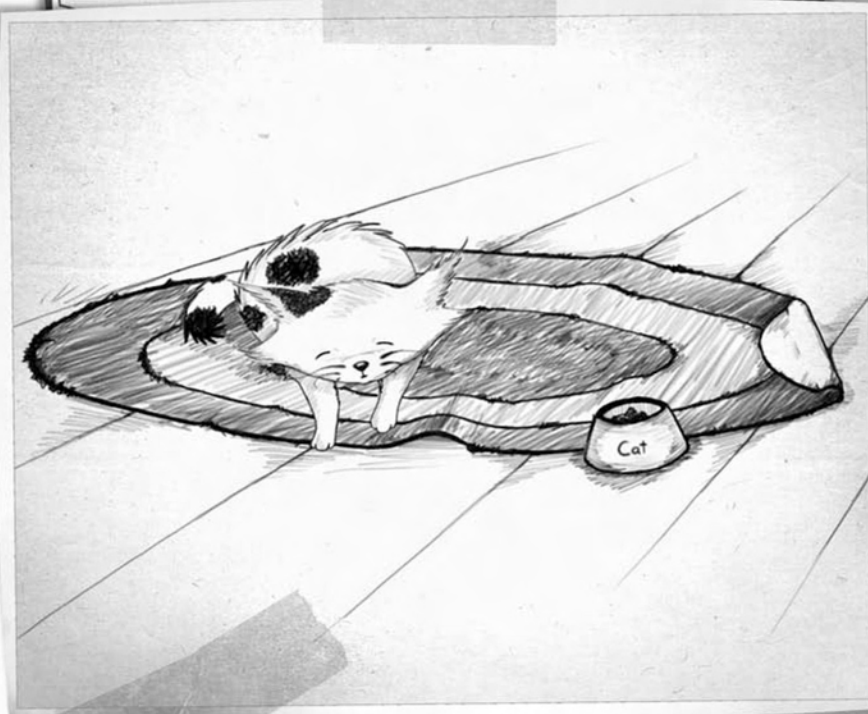


At sunset, Cobweb sang

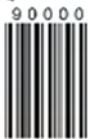
